MAKE DISCIPLES OF ALL NATIONS | DAVID ANDERSON

Do you know what you have been entrusted with in 2019?

To miss this is to miss the life for which Jesus recreated us. To miss this is to miss the joy and fulfillment that Jesus is offering. To miss this is to miss the greatest, most fulfilling adventure of your life. Jesus leaves no ambiguity about what He has entrusted to us. There is no confusion about His calling on our lives:

All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age (Matthew 28:18-20).

Jesus bookends His Great Commission with these words, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me . . . I will be with you always, even to the end of the age." Jesus says - I have total authority in this world and I won't leave you. No matter how people respond or what they do to you, I will be with you. I am the One who loved you and gave myself for you.

Jesus wants you to make disciples of all the nations. And if you sense God moving in your life, this promise is meant to help you say yes. Whatever assignments you have this year, Jesus has total authority and you never will be alone.

Jesus' promises of having all authority and never leaving us are in essence Him saying: I know you are helpless. I know you cannot keep the commandments, let alone teach others to keep them. Therefore, come to Me. Trust Me. Dwell with Me and I will produce the fruit.
