Leader: As we prepare our hearts and minds to celebrate the joy of Easter, we take time on this night to remember how our Savior chose to spend his final moments before his arrest and crucifixion. We refer to this as the Last Supper.

It was just before the Passover Festival. Jesus knew that the hour had come for him to leave this world and go to the Father. Having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. John 13:1

The Last Supper was a time of fellowship, teaching, worship, and prayer. Tonight we will take turns reading several passages of scripture, pray, eat, and sing, but do not worry about following the script perfectly or adhering to a timely order of events. 3. Read *Psalm 115:1*

1. First reading. *John 13:3-5, 12-17*
2. Hosts serve meal
3. Second Reading. *John 13:21-30*
4. Third Reading. (Pass juice and loaf of bread.) *Mark 14:22-25*
5. Sing/Read *Psalm 116*
6. Fourth Reading. *Luke 22:24-27*
7. Fifth Reading. *Matthew 26:31-35*
8. Sixth Reading. *John 13:34-35*

Dessert/Fellowship

Worship

1. Read *Psalm 118*
2. Sing *Cornerstone*
