AN ACCEPTABLE SACRIFICE

PHILIPPIANS 4:14-20

Remember the first dollar you ever earned? What did you feel when the first paycheck, allowance or baby-sitting money was placed in your hands?

For some of us those dollars symbolized power. We felt powerful, strong or important. For others, those dollars immediately elicited buying power and the capacity to get the things our little hearts most wanted. For others, those dollars made us feel secure and stuffing those dollars away in our sock drawer could allow us to hang on a little longer to those feelings of security.

What was it for you?

Whatever happened in your little heart years ago was extremely significant. The combination of our broken, sinful hearts, the homes that we grew up in, and this oppressive, materialistic culture we live in can be a vicious recipe on our hearts. We have so many things against us in how we view money and possessions. That's why I think God spends so much time addressing these topics in Scripture.

As we pray this prayer in 2020 - Father, pour out your Spirit on us and move us forward together - He is going to address our dysfunctional hearts towards money. Are you ready for it?
