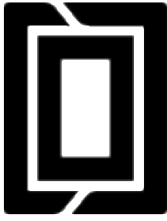

REGULAR HUB NOTES **An Acceptable Sacrifice** **Philippians 4:14-20**

1. What are your money issues? When it comes to finances and stewardship, where do you feel dysfunctional?

- Are you a fearful saver?
- Are you a compulsive shopper?
- Are you always lacking because of life circumstances and challenges?
- Are you generous to a fault?
- Are you controlling and obsessed?

2. Scripture ties our stewardship to our heart towards God and His provision. Is this fair or unfair? Why is Jesus concerned about your view of money and stewardship?

Read Philippians 4:14-20.

3. Why do you think that Paul calls their gift a “sweet-smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God”?

4. Is the promise in Verse 19, “And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus,” a promise for all Christians or just those who trust God with their finances?

5. Does it frustrate you that this is a conditional promise?

6. Why do the leaders of the church want you to think through this 2020 Stewardship Card? What questions do you have about this card?

7. What if the Holy Spirit is trying to get your attention in this area of finances? Is your stewardship “a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, very pleasing to God”? What could He be asking you to trust Him with?
