DAVID ANDERSON | THE LORD IS OUR HIDING PLACE SEPTEMBER 20, 2020 HUB NOTES

1) Brainstorm as a HUB group. What are the top 5 reasons why Christians stay in hiddenness and do not trust confession?

Make a list.

Let us just “pretend” that you hide. Which of these reasons compels you to stay hidden?

2) Review. Why is David called the “the man after God’s own heart”?

David committed three of the worst sins listed in the 10 commandments (adultery, murder, coveting, etc.). He was an absolute mess spiritually at very significant times of his life. Yet when confronted with sin, He turned to God and asked for healing.

3) How does David compare and contrast someone who confesses and someone who stays hidden?

For those who confess:

- You may be found
- You are my hiding place
- You shall preserve me from trouble
- You shall surround me with songs of deliverance
- I will guide you with My eye
- Mercy shall surround him
- Be glad and shout for joy

For those who don’t confess:

- No understanding
- Harnessed with bit and bridle
- Many sorrows

Which of these results stand out to you and why?

4) Can you remember a time in your life where God had to harness you with bit and bridle? What was that like?

5) What’s the difference between hiding from God and making Him our hiding place?

David says in verse 7, "You are my hiding place, you shall surround me." Here in verse 10 David says, "He who trusts in the Lord, mercy shall surround him. Be glad! Shout for joy!" Any hiding place that does not have God there with us is no hiding place at all. Stop hiding from God and allow Him to be your hiding place, refuge and healing.
