## REVIVE US: HOLY SPIRIT SERIES | NOVEMBER 1, 2020

### LEADER HUB GROUP NOTES

In this HUB discussion we will be talking about four divine attributes of the Holy Spirit. These are attributes that are only possessed by God.

The example given is His omnipresence. After that are listed three groups: Group 1 is eternal, Group 2 is omnipotence and Group 3 is omniscience. We want the HUB group members to study the scriptures and see if they can work their way to the theological category.

1. Begin the evening by demonstrating the discussion process for the group using Psalm 139: 7-10. The verses show that the Holy Spirit is present everywhere, which is the divine attribute of omnipresence. Read the passage with the group and help them to develop this connection.
2. Divide the group into three small groups to read the assigned verses. Make explicit connections from the passages to specific divine attributes of the Holy Spirit. (5 minutes)
3. Bring the groups together and have the small groups share out their conclusions. Discuss how each attribute of the Holy Spirit affects our walk as Christians. (20 minutes)
4. Answer a couple of concluding questions.

#### Example (Omnipresence)

- Psalm 139:7-10: <sup>7</sup> Where can I go from your Spirit?  
Where can I flee from your presence?  
<sup>8</sup> If I go up to the heavens, you are there;  
if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.  
<sup>9</sup> If I rise on the wings of the dawn,  
if I settle on the far side of the sea,  
<sup>10</sup> even there your hand will guide me,  
your right hand will hold me fast

#### Group 1 (Eternal)

- Heb.9:14: How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!
- Genesis 1:2: The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. (This verse shows that the Spirit was present at the creation, which points to Him being eternal and he was also active in the process which shows his power.)

### Group 2 (Omnipotence)

- Luke 1:35: The angel answered, “The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.”
- Acts 1:8: But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”
- Genesis 1:2: The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

### Group 3 (Omniscience)

- 1 Corinthians 2:10: “these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who knows a person’s thoughts except their own spirit within them? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.”
- John 16:13: When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.
- 1 Corinthians 2:13: And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.

### Concluding Questions:

Why does it matter that the Holy Spirit is God?

If He wasn’t God, what would change?
