**3) Read each case study and determine as a HUB group how to help this person identify the flesh's stranglehold over his/her life and possible steps of walking with the Holy Spirit.**

Case study #1: Jim and Maria have been married for 15 years , have three children and have experienced relative success in their professions. Over the last year something has changed in their relationship. Things feel distant and tense and adversarial. Laughter and smiles have turned into silence and questioning of motive. Both Jim and Maria fantasize about being with more loving partners and greener pastures. Each day it just seems to get worse.

- What are some possible steps of walking with the Spirit?

Case study #2: Every time Cindy gets on Facebook and Instagram, she is reminded of the life that she does not have but deeply desires. Each image sends her into an envious frenzy and frustration over the jobs she doesn't have, the vacations she can't go on, the health and finances that limit her and the relationships that she will never experience.
